### MAINE COMMUNITY COLLEGE SYSTEM BOARD OF TRUSTEES TO MEET AT KVCC

AUGUSTA, ME. – A regularly-scheduled meeting of the Maine Community College System (MCCS) Board of Trustees will be held on Wednesday, June 27, at Kennebec Valley Community College (KVCC) in Fairfield. The meeting will begin at 11:15 a.m. and will be held in the Conference Room on the lower level of the Frye Building.

Agenda items include the following:

- **Recognition of George J. Mitchell Peace Scholarship Recipients:** Joshua Beaulé of Lewiston, a student at Central Maine Community College, and Caroline Provost of Embden, a student at KVCC, will be recognized as the 2007 recipients of the George J. Mitchell Peace Scholarship. Both students will study in Ireland in Fall 2007.
- **Biennial Budget Update:** MCCS President John Fitzsimmons will update the Board on the State budget passed earlier this month.
- **Naming of EMCC Residence Hall:** The Board will vote to approve Kineo Hall as the name of the newly constructed residence hall at Eastern Maine Community College.
- **Approval of tuition and room and board rates for 2007-2008:** The Board will vote on tuition rates for the 2007-2008 academic year and will also establish room and board rate ranges, effective Fall 2007.

Other agenda items include:

- **Amendment to MCCS Policy:** The Board will vote to establish criteria for the awarding of advanced certificates for occupational programs of study.
- **Amendments to Strategic Plan:** The Board will vote to amend three of the measures currently used in the 2002-2008 MCCS Strategic Plan.
- **Acceptance of Gifts:** The Board will vote to accept a number of gifts to EMCC.
- **Election of Officers:** The Board will also elect officers for 2007-2008.
