- Be a full-time, matriculated student in the Maine Community College System (MCCS) and enrolled in an associate degree program or have graduated from MCCS in 2014.
- Have completed at least one semester by the application deadline or be set to graduate from MCCS in May 2015.
- Have a grade point average of 3.0 or higher.
