How do I sign up? Just apply to one of Maine's seven community colleges! We'll assign you an advisor who will work with you to complete your financial aid application (aka the FAFSA) and pick out a program and classes. We can do it over the phone, on Zoom, or in person. No need to fill out any paperwork, the scholarship is automatic for graduates in qualifying years!

WHAT does it cover? The scholarship pays 100% of tuition after federal and state grant aid has been applied.

WHO is eligible? High school graduates with a diploma or its equivalent since 2024 qualify for the Maine Free College Scholarship. There are no income or age limits. Just pursue a degree or certificate at least part time, be a Maine resident, and accept any state or federal aid you qualify for. That's it!
