Chair Clark determined that a quorum of Trustees was present and that no one from the public wished to address the Board of Trustees. The meeting was called to order at 1:15 p.m.

ACCEPTANCE OF MINUTES

Resolution to accept Minutes of the April 29, 2015 meeting

A MOTION was made, and seconded by Trustee Ginn Marvin to accept the minutes. It was unanimously approved.

Resolution to accept Minutes of the May 22, 2015 meeting

A **MOTION** was made by Trustee Ginn Marvin and seconded by Trustee MacMahon to accept the minutes. It was unanimously approved.

CHAIR'S REMARKS

Chair Clark thanked both President Joe Cassidy and Trustee Bill Cassidy for the lovely dinner the previous evening.

PRESIDENT'S REMARKS

Interim President Langhauser described a notable absence at the meeting with Ellyn Chase not in attendance. He stated that so many people there had known Ellyn Chase for so many years, and that he knew everyone's thoughts and prayers were with her as she cared for her mother.

Resolution regarding Tuition and Fees for Fiscal Year 2016

Chair Clark discussed the resolution, which would freeze tuition and fee rates, contingent upon the State budget.

A **MOTION** was made by Trustee Ginn Marvin, and was seconded. It was unanimously approved.

<u>Resolution confirming President Emeritus Status to Dr. Barbara W. Woodlee</u> In Dr. Woodlee's absence, the Board assented her worthiness of the title.

A **MOTION** was made and seconded to approve President Emeritus status. It was unanimously approved.

Resolution confirming Faculty Emeritus Status to Edward Raymaker

It was noted by Derek Langhauser that Edward Raymaker is a long-standing and much beloved faculty member at EMCC.

A **MOTION** was made by Trustee MacMahon, and seconded, to approve Faculty Emeritus status. It was unanimously approved.

EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE

Resolution to authorize a naming opportunity at the Midcoast Campus of SMCC

Derek Langhauser thanked Lisa Gorman, the John T. Gorman Foundation, and the LL Bean Corporation for the funding to help establish the mid-coast campus. Naming the building "LL Bean Learning Commons and Health Science Center" is the System's way of thanking them for their incredible generosity.

A MOTION was made and seconded to approve the naming. It was unanimously approved.

<u>Resolution to approve MCCS Policy 413: College Presidential Searches, as amended</u> Chair Clark noted that the Trustees had amended this policy during the work session that morning.

A MOTION was made and seconded to approve language. It was unanimously approved.

Resolution to authorize the awarding of Faculty Emeritus Status to Nancy Smith

Derek Langhauser noted that he could speak personally to the worthiness of Ms. Smith. Nancy Smith was a faculty member at SMCC for 29 years; she was chair of the Nursing Department, and chair of the Health Sciences division. Over the years, she is responsible for the training of thousands of nursing students who have tended to over a million patients. Derek Langhauser worked with her directly upon numerous occasions, and stated that he could think of few people as hard-working, knowledgeable, and decent as Nancy, and no one he would recommend as highly for this honor.

A MOTION was made and seconded to authorize the award. It was unanimously approved.

EDUCATION COMMITTEE

<u>Resolution</u> to authorize implementation of a two-year Associate in Applied Science in Management Information Systems at CMCC

Trustee MacMahon introduced the resolution, explaining that it is a combination of both business and computer technology programs.

A **MOTION** was made by Trustee MacMahon and seconded by Trustee Cassidy to accept this program. It was unanimously approved.

<u>Resolution</u> to authorize implementation of a two-year Associate of Applied Science in Sustainable Design/Build at KVCC

Trustee MacMahon discussed the resolution, stating that it is a continuation of a TAACCCT IV grant program which KVCC has been running.

A **MOTION** was made by Trustee MacMahon and seconded by Trustee Sexton to accept this program. It was unanimously approved.

FINANCE COMMITTEE

Resolution to approve the Fiscal 2016 Budget for MCCS

Trustee Ginn Marvin thanked Derek Langhauser and David Daigler for their hard work on the budget this year. The Finance Committee has already met and approved this budget.

A **MOTION** was made by Trustee Ginn Marvin, and seconded, to accept the budget. It was unanimously approved.

There was some discussion by the Trustees on approval of the tuition freeze and the focus on maintaining low costs for our students. Trustee Sexton added that she would like to see the colleges move away from renting space in some cases where they could purchase.
