MCCS BOARD OF TRUSTEES TO HONOR STUDENTS OF THE YEAR Board will also hold regularly scheduled meetings on Wednesday

AUGUSTA, ME — Seven Maine community college students will be honored on Wednesday for their academic success and campus and community involvement at a ceremony hosted by the Maine Community College System (MCCS) Board of Trustees.

The 2015 Student of the Year Awards ceremony will be held Wednesday, April 29, at the Senator Inn in Augusta. The ceremony will start at 10:30 am followed by a luncheon. The 2015 MCCS Students of the Year are:

The award winners were selected by college faculty and staff. Each of the students will be awarded a John H. Lapoint, Jr. Leadership Award in the amount of \$1,000. Mr. Lapoint was president of UF Strainrite in Lewiston and a trustee of the Maine Community College System. After his death in 1995, his widow, Jana Lapoint, served on the Board from 1995 to 2006 and helped establish the fund for the annual awards.
