FREE COLLEGE SCHOLARSHIP

To qualify students must:

- ▶ Have a HS diploma or equivalent from 2020-23
- Enroll full time
- ▶ Pursue a degree or academic credential
- ► Live in Maine while enrolled
- Noncitizens qualify for the scholarship
- Automatic scholarship for current students who qualify





FREE COLLEGE FACTS

WHO is eligible? If you graduated high school (or earned the equivalent of a high school diploma) in 2020, 2021, 2022, or 2023 – you're eligible. There are no income or age limits. Just enroll full time in a degree or certificate program, live in Maine while enrolled, and accept any state or federal aid you qualify for. That's it!

WHAT does it cover? This

scholarship pays for up to two years of tuition and mandatory fees, after federal and state grant aid has been applied.

HOW do I sign up? Just apply to one of Maine's seven community colleges! We'll assign you an advisor who will work with you to complete your financial aid application (aka the FAFSA) and pick out a program and classes. We can do it over the phone, on Zoom, or in person. If you are already enrolled at a community college, the scholarship is automatic – you don't need to fill out any extra paperwork!


