Reporting directly to the Chief Information Officer, this position will plan, build, and implement an infrastructure for reporting and responding to advanced analytical needs in support of a data-driven, evidence-based culture of student success for the MCCS. The position is responsible for design, development and maintenance of databases and analyzing large complex data sets. The position will build complex data tables and develop reports from a variety of data sources for dissemination, presentation and explanation to System leadership, in addition to developing queries for data extraction and analysis. The Research Analyst/Programmer Administrator will also work closely with the MCCS Director of Institutional Research in conducting appropriate statistical analyses of data to maximize the value of the results to the Maine Community College System. Bachelor's degree in a quantitative field or a field requiring research analysis, with 5-7 years' experience in advanced data analysis and programming, including experience with Microsoft SQL Server and T SQL skills required, preferably in a higher education setting.
